Suggested Dues Level: \$1,000 (\$500 if after October 1)

For-profit entities with annual revenue or operating budgets of less than \$10 million

Suggested Dues Level: \$300 (\$150 if after October 1)

Not-for-profit entities (includes government agencies, academic institutions, and NGOs)
