

200 BC - Health effects of lead first stated by the Greek physician Dioscerides: "Lead makes the mind give way"

September 2, 1977 - The United States government's Consumer Product Safety Commission banned lead paint in 1977 (16 Code of Federal Regulations CFR 1303).

2011 - Lead is still used in flashing and roofing, radiation shielding, solder, and electrical cable jacketing.

WHAT

The Health Product Declaration Open Standard is a standard format that systematizes reporting language to enable transparent disclosure of Information regarding building product content and associated health information, by defining the critical information that is needed by building designers, specifiers, owners and users

HOW

It is an open standard, freely available to all.

By providing a common language, the HPD helps manufacturers communicate important data in a consistent manner so that customers can make fully informed decisions about the health profile of building products.


